EXECUTIVE OFFICER'S UPDATE

On October 6th, the San Diego LAFCO unanimously approved the activation of County Service Area No. 135's latent fire protection and emergency medical services powers. This action will extend improved life safety services to nearly 1 million acres of territory in unserved or underserved San Diego County. The effective date for this action will be in calendar year 2008.

October 3 was the election deadline for one regular special district position on LAFCO and eight positions on LAFCO's Special Districts Advisory Committee. The incumbent LAFCO Regular member, Bud Pocklington (South Bay Irrigation District) received 30 votes and was reelected to a new four-year term on the Commission. His challenger, Martin Marugg (Alpine Fire Protection District) received 9 votes. With respect to the advisory committee, seven incumbent members were reelected: Dennis Shepard (North County Cemetery District), Jo MacKenzie (Vista Irrigation District), Diana Towne (Rincon del Diablo MWD), Gary Arant (Valley Center MWD), Augie Scalzitti (Padre Dam

MWD), James Alkire (South Bay ID), and Ron Fuller (Alpine FPD). One new member, Douglas Humphrey (Resource Conservation District of Greater San Diego County) was elected. Committee members serve four-year terms.

On October 17-19, Commissioner and CWA & MET Board Member Pocklington hosted a water infrastructure tour of the Delta in Northern California. LAFCO Consultant Harry Ehrlich joined about 30 other government officials on the tour.
