4. DC08-11 Proposed "Consolidation of the East County and the San Miguel Consolidated Fire Protection Districts" (*The proposal was initiated by unanimous resolutions of the Boards of Directors for the East County and San Miguel Consolidated Fire Protection Districts (FPD). The reasons for the proposal are to consolidate two fire protection districts into a single successor agency, which would be known as the San Miguel Consolidated FPD, eliminate duplicate functions among the two single agencies, and redirect resources to enhance structural fire protection and emergency medical services within a southwesterly sub-region of unincorporated San Diego County.*)

At the hearing, the LAFCO Executive Officer shall hear or receive any oral or written protest, presented, or filed. Written protest to the consolidation from district landowners or registered voters residing in the subject territory must be filed with the LAFCO Executive Officer prior to the conclusion of the protest proceedings. Any person who has previously filed written protest may withdraw their protest at any time prior to the conclusion of the hearing. If insufficient protest is presented, the Executive Officer will order the Consolidation without an election subject to the Terms and Conditions of Consolidation.)

POLITICAL REFORM ACT AND LAFCO DISCLOSURE REQUIREMENTS

The Political Reform Act prohibits a person appointed to the Local Agency Formation Commission from soliciting or accepting campaign contributions of more than \$250 within the preceding 12 months from parties, participants, or their agents while a proceeding is pending before LAFCO and for three months following the decision. LAFCO commissioners who receive such contributions are required to disqualify themselves from participating in the proceedings. Both commissioners and contributors who are parties to the proceeding are required to disclose the contributions received or made.

In addition to the disclosure requirements discussed above, expenditures for political purposes related to a change of organization or reorganization proposal which has been submitted to the Commission, and contributions in support of or in opposition to such measures, shall be disclosed and reported to the same extent and subject to the same requirements as provided for local initiative measures presented to the electorate (Government Code Section 56700.1).

ACCESSIBILITY OF MEETINGS AND AGENDA MATERIALS

LAFCO agendas and documents included in the agenda packet are available in alternative formats, to persons with disabilities, as required by Section 202 of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C.
