3. PROTEST HEARING | (a) County Service Area No. 115 Reorganization No. 1 for San Miguel Consolidated Fire Protection District and (b) County Service Area No. 2 for Lakeside Fire Protection District | (RO14-12 et al. and RO14-13 et al.)

On October 1, 2018, the San Diego Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) adopted a resolution approving a reorganization to transfer fire protection and emergency medical service responsibilities within the unincorporated Pepper Drive community in east San Diego County. The approved reorganization involves the combining of two separate proposals filed by Lakeside Fire Protection District and San Miguel Consolidated Fire Protection District to concurrently (a) dissolve County Service Area No. 115 and (b) proportionally annex the approximate 441 acre affected territory in approximate equal halves based on assessed value. The resulting demarcation is Pepper Drive with land generally to the north annexing to Lakeside Fire Protection District and land generally to the south annexing to San Miguel Consolidated Fire Protection District. LAFCO approval is subject to protest proceedings.
