3. PROTEST HEARING | Alpine Islands Reorganization | (RO16-15 et al.)

On February 4, 2019, the San Diego Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) adopted a resolution approving the reorganization of the Alpine Islands Reorganization to transfer fire protection and emergency medical services from the County of San Diego and its Fire Authority through County Service Area No. 135 (CSA) to the Alpine Fire Protection District (FPD). Specific changes of organization involve (a) annexation to the Alpine FPD and, (b) divestiture of CSA No. 135's active latent powers for fire protection and emergency medical services within the affected territory. The LAFCo Resolution will be summarized at the hearing. Pursuant to the authority delegated by LAFCo and in accordance with Government Code section 57050, the Executive Officer shall hear and receive any oral or written protests or objections to the reorganization. All written protests must be submitted before the conclusion of the hearing. Any person who has filed a written protest may withdraw that protest at any time before the conclusion of the hearing. The hearing and valuation of the protests will be conducted in conformance with the Policy for the Conduct of Protest Proceedings adopted by LAFCo on March 13, 2019. Within 30 days of the conclusion of the protest hearing, the Executive Officer shall determine the value of written protests filed and not withdrawn and make the findings required by law.

4. PROTEST HEARING | County Service Area No. 135 (Fire/EMS) Islands 2, 3, &4 Reorganization | (RO16-20 et al.)

On February 4, 2019, the San Diego Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) adopted a resolution approving the reorganization of County Service Area No. 135 Islands 2,3, & 4 Reorganization to establish formal fire protection and emergency medical services within three large unserved territory (Islands 2, 3, and 4) and involve (a) annexation to the Bonita-Sunnyside Fire Protection District (FPD), Lakeside FPD, San Miguel Consolidated FPD, and Ramona Municipal Water District and, (b) latent power area expansion of County Service Area No. 135. The LAFCo Resolution will be summarized at the hearing. Pursuant to the authority delegated by LAFCo and in accordance with Government Code section 57050, the Executive Officer shall hear and receive any oral or written protests or objections to the reorganization. All written protests must be submitted before the conclusion of the hearing. Any person who has filed a written protest may withdraw that protest at any time before the conclusion of the hearing. The hearing and valuation of the protests will be conducted in conformance with the Policy for the Conduct of Protest Proceedings adopted by LAFCo on March 13, 2019. Within 30 days of the conclusion of the protest hearing, the Executive Officer shall determine the value of written protests filed and not withdrawn and make the findings required by law.
