The application is now complete and contains the information required by State Law and the Commission's rules. A negotiated property tax exchange agreement pertinent to this jurisdictional change is on file. Therefore, pursuant to Section 56658 of the California Government Code, this Certificate of Filing is hereby issued on June 5, 2015.

This proposal will be considered by the Commission at a meeting to be held on July 6, 2015, and scheduled to begin at 9:00 a.m., in Room 310 of the County Administration Center, 1600 Pacific Highway, San Diego. This proposal will be a public hearing item.

If the San Diego LAFCO approves the proposed reorganization, then State Law requires that protest proceedings be conducted. The purpose of protest proceedings is to provide landowners and registered voters an opportunity to file written protest, and depending upon the level of protest, either terminate proceedings, or force the matter to be placed on the ballot.
