

## **Table Summary**

Tab 1 – “Census Tract Info” – Lists the number of Latinos in FPUD territory, by age and census tract. We used this data to identify the precincts with larger Latino populations. Then we looked at how the precincts with larger Latino populations voted, and compared those percentages with the non-Latino precincts.

The following table summarizes the findings contained in the spreadsheet. You can see that precincts within Latino populated census tracts tend to vote for the candidate with the Spanish surname.

This demonstrates racial polarized voting in the FPUD area – proving FPUD’s at large election system disenfranchises voters.
