NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given the San Diego County Local Agency Formation Commission (“LAFCO”) will hold a public meeting on **Monday, April 4, 2022 at 9:00 a.m.** at the County of San Diego Administration Center at 1600 Pacific Highway, Room 302, San Diego, California. At the public meeting, LAFCO will consider the following public hearing matter:

PROPOSED “FALLBROOK PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT LATENT POWERS ACTIVATION” LAFCO FILE NO. LP19-27

The referenced public hearing involves consideration of an application by the Fallbrook Public Utility District (PUD) to activate certain latent powers throughout the PUD’s approximately 28,000-acre jurisdictional boundary. The requested activations involve the following functions: parks and recreation; roads, streets and highways; and street lighting. LAFCO will consider the merits of the application relative to statutory directives and local policies to facilitate the orderly development of local agencies. Key considerations include the timing of the requested activations and PUD’s ability to provide these functions without adversely impacting existing service functions. LAFCO retains discretion to approve the proposal with or without modifications as well as with or without conditions.

Documents regarding the reorganization proposal item will be available for review on LAFCO’s internet website at www.sdlafco.org no later than 96-hours before the scheduled hearing. The public is encouraged to review these materials and provide comments before or during the April 4th public hearing. Importantly, should LAFCO approve the proposal, a subsequent protest hearing for all landowners and registered voters within the affected territory will be separately noticed.

In addition to attending in person, staff anticipates the ability of the public to participate in the April 4th public meeting remotely through videoconference or telephone. The meeting will also be live streamed online. The public is encouraged to contact LAFCO before the meeting to confirm the availability of remote participation.
