Good morning. Realize this is probably too late but thought I'd send it anyway...

I am the treasurer of the Fallbrook Beautification Alliance and, while I am not speaking on behalf of the board of that organization, as an individual who is part of that group I can tell you firsthand about the commitment of ours and many other volunteer organizations in Fallbrook that work tirelessly to keep Fallbrook the place that both residents and visitors enjoy as an attractive and vibrant community. Just one example of those efforts—since 2019, our Fallbrook Beautification Alliance volunteers have spent 4,463 hours collecting 13,249 5-gallon-bucket equivalents of trash in Fallbrook and Bonsall. Our organization pays for the maintenance of the landscaping on South Mission Road's medians (a lovely entrance to Fallbrook) and supplies and maintains the attractive potted plants on Main Avenue. We apply for grants, but rely primarily on individual donations. A regular source of funding would allow us to continue and enhance our efforts, and the activation of Fallbrook Public Utilities District latent powers would provide the greatest level of local control and benefits to our community.

We hope that you will recognize the benefit of this request and take action to ensure the support it will give our community.
