**SUBJECT: Annual Report |
 Sphere of Influence and Municipal Service Review Summary of Actions**

SUMMARY

The San Diego Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) will receive an annual report chronicling sphere of influence and municipal service review actions in San Diego County. This includes updating the annual report to account for actions taken in 2021 and marked by approving 19 distinct sphere actions ranging from applicant proposed amendments to comprehensive agency updates undertaken by the Commission. The report serves as the official registry cataloging all related actions and is being presented for formal filing.

BACKGROUND

Current Workplan

San Diego LAFCO’s current workplan identifies the publication of an updated annual report tracking the Commission’s municipal service review and sphere of influence amendments and/or update actions. This municipal service review and sphere of influence summary project has been part of the annual workplan since the early 2000s.

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DISCUSSION

This item is for San Diego LAFCO to receive the attached annual report chronicling sphere of influence and municipal service review actions in San Diego County. The report has been prepared consistent with the adopted workplan and serves as the official record of all sphere establishments and subsequent changes since 1972 as well as cataloging municipal service reviews beginning in 2001. The report also includes an appendix providing current sphere maps for all agencies under Commission oversight.

With respect to spheres of influence, the Commission approved 19 distinct actions in 2021 divided between one establishment, thirteen amendments (expansion or reductions) and five comprehensive updates listed below.
