NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given the San Diego County Local Agency Formation Commission (“LAFCO”) will hold a public meeting on **Monday, October 3, 2022 at 9:00 a.m.** at the County of San Diego Administration Center at 1600 Pacific Highway, Room 302, San Diego, California. Attendance by videoconference via live-streaming is also anticipated to accommodate additional physical distancing due to the COVID-19 pandemic. At the public meeting, LAFCO will consider the following public hearing matter:

- PROPOSED “COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 69 REORGANIZATION” -
DISSOLUTION OF COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO.69 AND DESIGNATION OF LAKESIDE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT AND CITY OF SANTEE AS SUCESSOR AGENCIES AND RELATED ACTIONS

During the public hearing, LAFCO will consider the reorganization proposal filed by resolution of the County of San Diego involving approximately 40,320 acres of unincorporated territory within County Service Area (CSA) No. 69’s jurisdictional boundary. The proposed reorganization involves the dissolution of CSA No.69 and further requests Lakeside Fire Protection District (FPD) and the City of Santee proportionally serve as the successor agencies and assume CSA No. 69’s active ambulance transport services within their jurisdictional boundary and estimated resident population of 135,468. The proposal also involves a concurrent request by the County of San Diego to annex two areas located in the unincorporated communities of Bostonia and Pepper Drive to Lakeside FPD for ambulance services only as fire protection services are already provided by the San Miguel Fire Protection District. A possible modification of the proposal by staff is also under consideration to expand the annexation to Lakeside FPD of an additional 3,274 unincorporated acres and in doing so address a preexisting term applied to the FPD as part of the “CSA 135 Islands Annexation” approval in February 2019.

Documents regarding the reorganization proposal item – including a map of the proposed affected territory – are available for viewing online at www.sdlafco.org now and will include posting of the staff report and recommendation no later than 96-hours before the scheduled hearing. The public is encouraged to review these materials, provide comments, and attend the public hearing on Monday, October 3rd. Additional details on public participation and submittal of comments are also available at the LAFCO website. Importantly, should LAFCO approve the proposal, a subsequent protest hearing for all landowners and registered voters within the affected territory will be separately noticed.
