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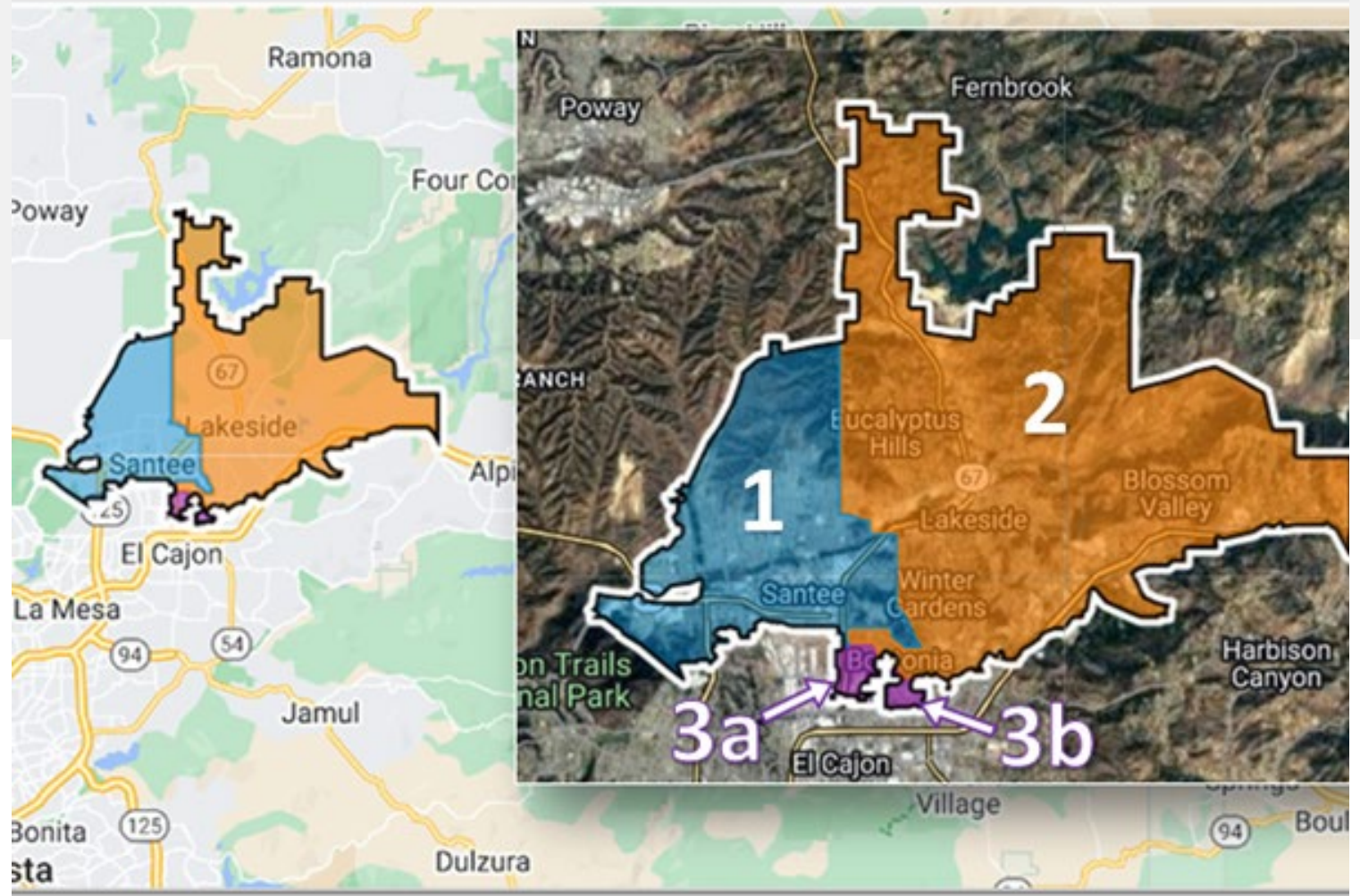

Key Terms & Conditions



The two successor agencies to CSA No. 69 – Lakeside FPD and Santee – will create a joint powers authority to manage the provision of service within the affected territory in the same scope and manner as is currently provided.



The successor agencies and/or joint powers authority will assume all costs and responsibility for service, dispatch, billing, and other administrative costs, and determine transport fees for residents and non-residents.



All CSA No. 69 property tax allocation, benefit fees, and reserves will go to the two successor agencies for the sole purpose of providing ambulance transport service



The successor agencies will maintain the current ambulance transport levels consisting of 4 paramedic ambulances staffed 24/7 year-round, two of which are provided by each agency

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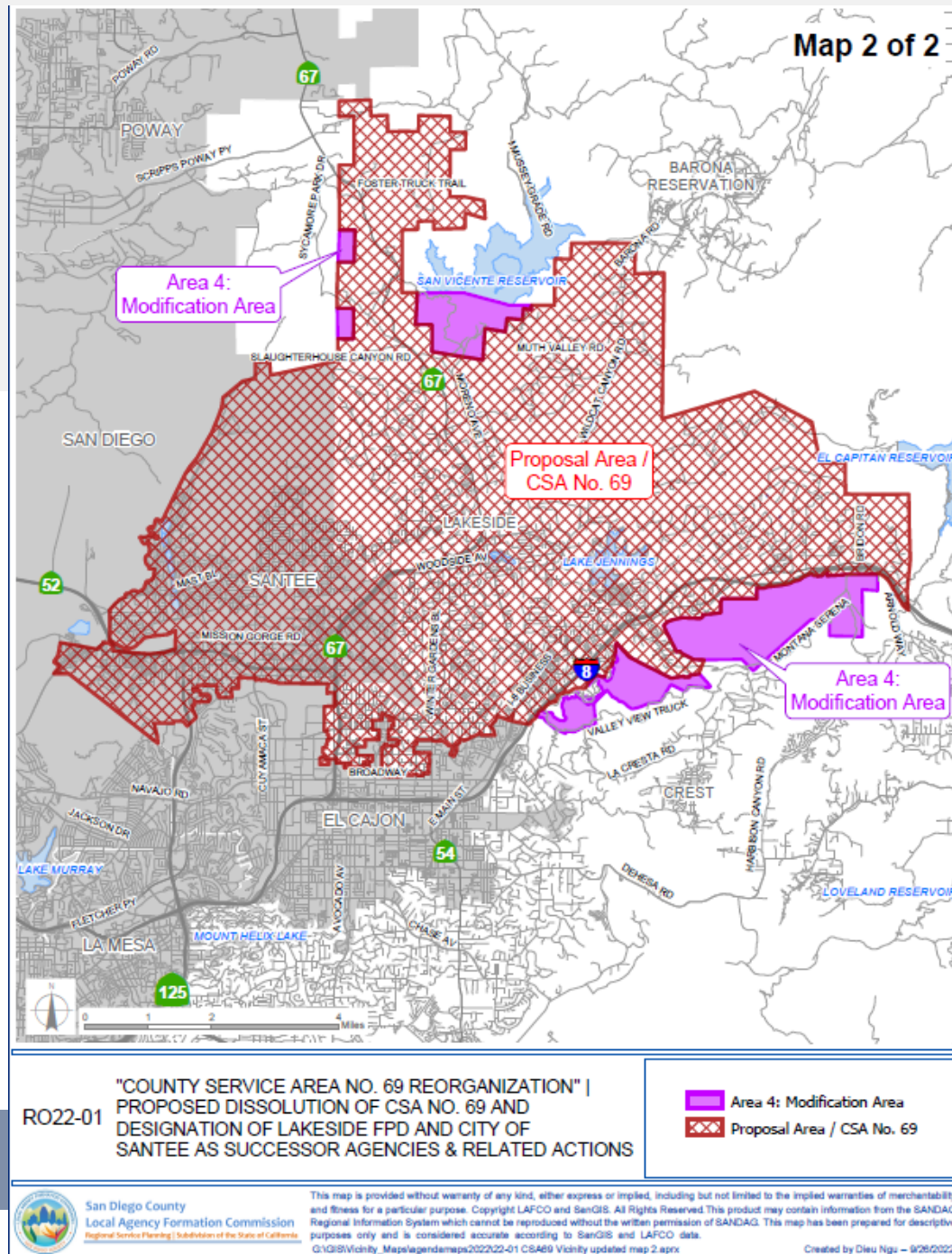

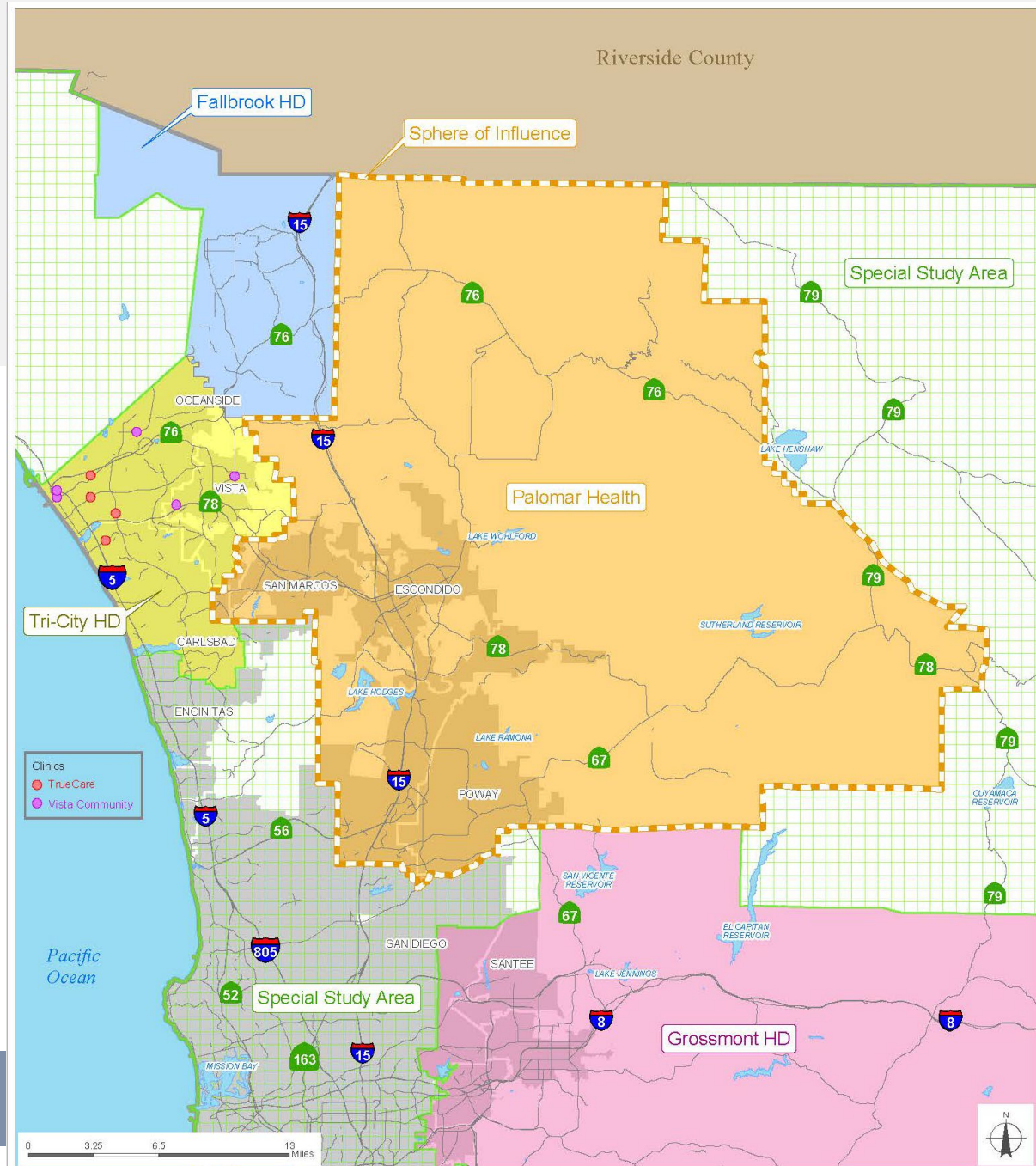

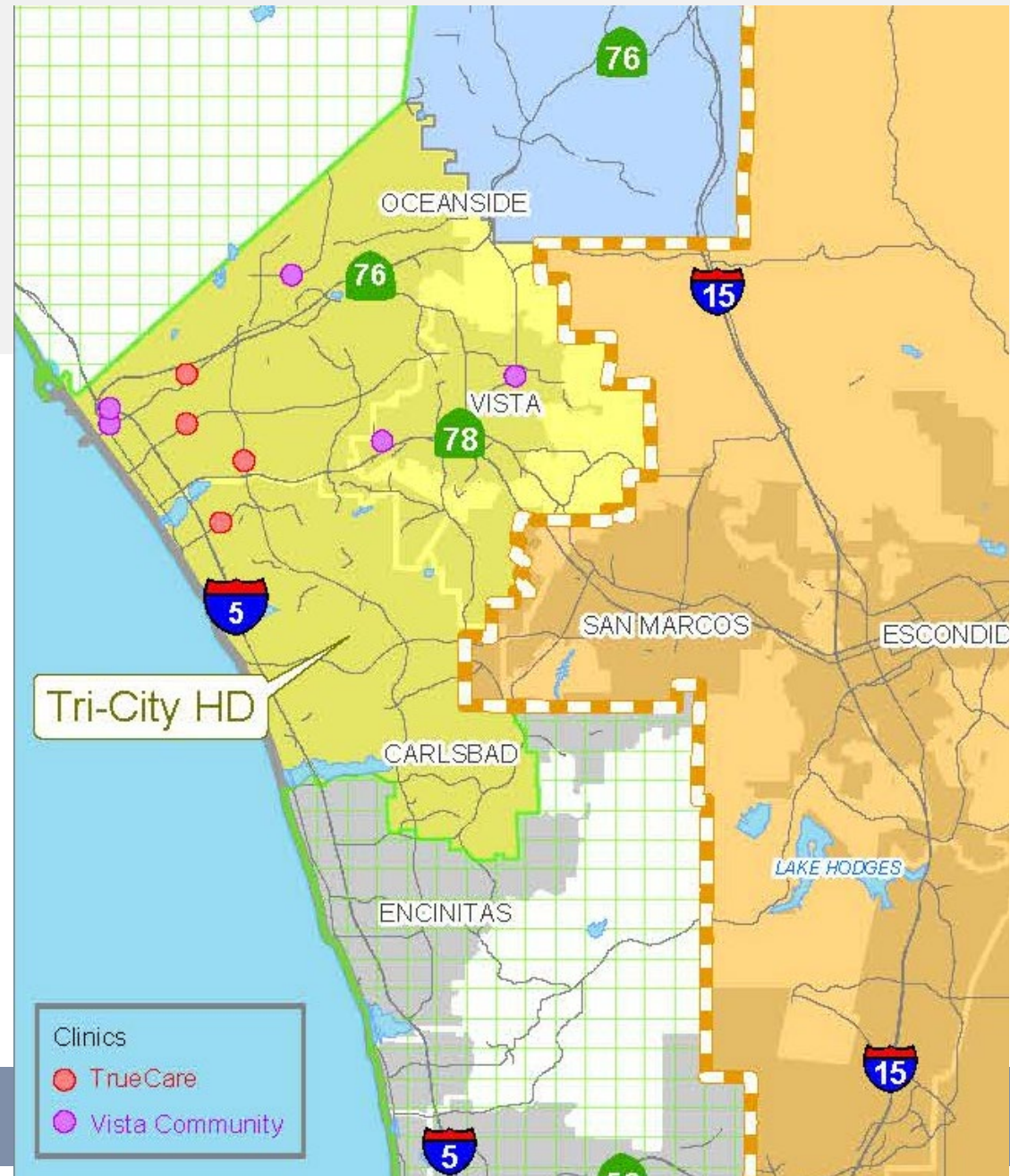

Draft Policy Update on Municipal Service Reviews

Part of the Adopted Workplan

Premise is to Reflect Current/Best Practices Over Past 20 Years

Key Revisions:

1. Make Explicit the Role of MSRs
 - Guide Scope of Subsequent Sphere Updates
2. Maintain 5-year Study Schedule
3. New MSRs Needed After 5-Years to Accommodate Applicant Proposals
4. Delegate Preparation/Scope Fully to EO
5. Address Community Engagement
