**RESOLUTION OF THE
SAN DIEGO COUNTY LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION
MAKING DETERMINATIONS**

MUNICIPAL SERVICE REVIEW ON THE OCEANSIDE REGION

WHEREAS, the San Diego County Local Agency Formation Commission, hereinafter referred to as the “Commission”, is a political subdivision of the State of California with regulatory and planning responsibilities to facilitate orderly municipal growth and development under the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Commission is responsible under Government Code Section 56430 to regularly prepare municipal service reviews to independently and comprehensively evaluate the sufficiency of local governmental services to inform its regulatory and other planning activities; and

WHEREAS, the Commission adopted a workplan calendaring projects for 2024-2025; and

WHEREAS, the Commission’s Executive Officer and staff prepared a region-specific municipal service review on the Oceanside area consistent with statute and the adopted workplan; and

WHEREAS, the municipal service review on the Oceanside region covers three local agencies under the Commission’s oversight: City of Oceanside, Oceanside Small Craft Harbor District, and Morro Hills Community Services District; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Officer’s written report on the municipal service review was presented to the Commission in a manner provided by law; and

WHEREAS, the Commission heard and fully considered all the evidence presented at public meetings involving the municipal service review on June 3, 2024, August 5, 2024, and October 7, 2024 ;

WHEREAS, as part of the municipal service review, the Commission is required pursuant to Government Code Section 56430(a) to make a statement of written determinations with regard to certain factors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Commission hereby finds, determines, and orders the following:

1. The Commission determines this municipal service review is a project under the California Environmental Quality Act but qualifies for an exemption from further action as an informational document consistent with State Guidelines Section 15306.

2. The Commission has duly considered the Executive Officer's written report on the municipal service review and recommendations therein on the availability, need, and sufficiency of public services provided within the Oceanside region relative to community needs.
3. The Commission independently makes all of the written determinations provided in the Executive Officer's written report on the municipal service review on the Oceanside region pursuant to Government Code Section 56340.
