SUBJECT: **Biennial Report | 2023 & 2024**
Sphere of Influence and Municipal Service Review Summary of Actions

SUMMARY

The San Diego Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) will receive a biennial report chronicling sphere of influence and municipal service review actions in San Diego County. The update covers calendar years 2023 and 2024 and marked by the Commission approving 26 distinct sphere actions as well as two municipal service reviews covering four local agencies. The biennial report serves as the official registry cataloging all related actions and is being presented to the Commission for formal filing.

BACKGROUND

It is the established practice for San Diego LAFCO to regularly prepare a report tracking the Commission’s municipal service review and sphere of influence actions. This practice has evolved from annual to biennial reporting. Completed reports are transmitted to cities and special districts to help ensure consistency across regional and local mapping records.

DISCUSSION

This item is for San Diego LAFCO to receive a biennial report chronicling approved municipal service review and sphere of influence actions in San Diego County for the 2023 and 2024 calendar years. The report serves as the official record of all sphere establishments and
